In the international arena Terry served as Senior Aviation Advisor for the U.S. Department of State in Baghdad, Iraq. Terry played a key role in establishing En Route radar services and implementing a robust training program for Iraq air traffic controllers at Baghdad Tower and Baghdad Area Control Center.
